



Guidelines on taking prednis(ol)one to prevent an Addison's crisis

Mild physical stress, for example:	Adjusting the prednis(ol)one dose
Intensive sport activity	It may be necessary to adjust the prednis(ol)one dosage. Discuss this with your treating endocrinologist.
Mild signs of disease (e.g. common cold) and a body temperature below 38.0 °C	You do not need to adjust the dosage. Unless you know from experience that you need extra prednis(ol)one for a quicker recovery. In that case, take 1.25 to 2.5 mg extra prednis(ol)one short term every day. You can, if appropriate, spread this extra dosage over the day.
Moderate physical stress, for example:	Adjusting the prednis(ol)one dose
Increasing signs of disease and/or temperature between 38.0 and 39.0 °C Short-term vomiting (once or twice) caused by the illness Short-term diarrhoea caused by the illness	Take an extra 5 mg prednis(ol)one (whole tablet) immediately. Double the daily dosage of prednis(ol)one and spread it over the morning and late afternoon. Take at least 5-5 mg prednis(ol)one. Do this for as long as you are ill. Does the fever last longer than 48 hours? If so, please contact your GP. Please indicate that you have adrenal insufficiency.
Dental surgery	Take an extra 2.5 mg prednis(ol)one one hour before the surgery.
Severe physical stress, for example:	Adjusting the prednis(ol)one dose
Severe signs of disease and/or temperature above 39.0 °C	Take an extra 5 mg prednis(ol)one immediately. Treble the daily dosage of prednis(ol)one and spread it over the morning and late afternoon. Take at least 7.5-7.5 mg prednis(ol)one. Do this for as long as you are ill. Does the fever last longer than 48 hours or do you feel seriously ill? If so, please contact your GP. Please indicate that you have adrenal insufficiency. If in doubt, call your endocrinologist.
Accident resulting in injury	Take an extra 5 mg prednis(ol)one (whole tablet). If necessary, call your endocrinologist.
Sustained vomiting Sustained watery diarrhoea: about once or twice an hour	Inject 100 mg hydrocortisone (SoluCortef®) into a muscle or subcutaneously. Then call your endocrinologist immediately.
Loss of consciousness/unconsciousness	Please call or get someone to call the regional/national emer- gency number Please indicate that you have adrenal insufficien- cy. Inject 100 mg hydrocortisone (SoluCortef®) into a muscle or subcutaneously. Call or get someone to call the endocrinologist.
Moderate mental stress, for example:	Adjusting the prednis(ol)one dose
Fear of visiting the dentist Nerves before an exam Job interview	You do not need to adjust the dosage. Unless you know from experience that symptoms which fit with adrenal insufficiency occur if you do not increase the prednis(ol)one. In that case, take a one-off extra 1 to 2.5 mg prednis(ol)one. Evaluate this with your treating endocrinologist.
Severe mental stress, for example:	Adjusting the prednis(ol)one dose
Death of a close relative Funeral Traumatic experience	Take an extra 5 mg prednis(ol)one (whole tablet). Then increase the daily dose short term (e.g. by doubling it). This depends on the degree of stress.
